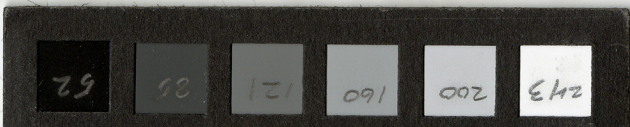

opportunity.

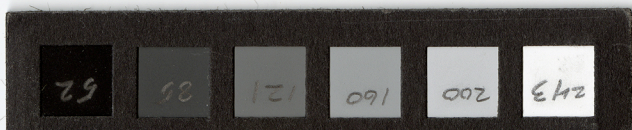

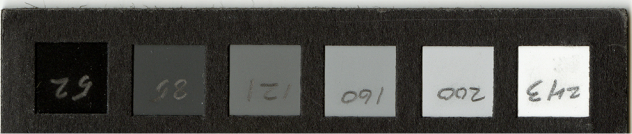
